

Truman Hoyle advises on technology deal

SYDNEY TECHNOLOGY and corporate law firm Truman Hoyle have advised Australian software company ComOps Ltd in successfully raising over \$8 million and on the negotiation and completion of the acquisition of Human Capital Solutions and Concentric Business Solutions. Shareholders approved the transactions and the acquisitions were finalised late last year.
